Adventure tips.

Switzerland is a country of many aspects. Her natural and cultural assets manifest a genuine quality grown over the centuries. Selected adventure excursions reveal the rich diversity of original and artless authenticity.

**Glacier 3000, 2,965 m**  
The glacier peak of Gstaad fascinates visitors with an impressive summit station and the Peak Walk by Tissot. This is a suspension bridge, 107 metres in length, spanning the abyss between two mountain peaks. At a dizzying altitude of 3,000 metres above sea level, no less!

**Lötschberg mountain route and Centovalli**  
Starting in Berne, the BLS RegionExpress Lötschberger sets off for Italy and offers striking views of Switzerland at its most authentic. From Domodossola, the Centovalli railway takes its guests through the "1100 valleys" of lush green pastures and spectacular waterfalls to Locarno.

**Pilatus, 2,132 m**  
Pilatus is accessible via two routes: by panorama gondola and aerial cableway, or by the world's steepest cog railway. Always an inspirational destination for people of all ages – with a rope park and a summer toboggan run, hotels and restaurants.

**Central Alps Passes PostBus Route**  
Starting from Meiringen and tackling four of the most impressive Swiss Alpine passes by Postbus in one single day, thereby negotiating a total altitude of 10,366 metres: This panorama tour represents the ultimate experience for Alpine enthusiasts. It can be experienced from June to October.

**Rochers-de-Naye, 2,042 m**  
Hiking trails at 2,000 metres altitude and flora from all over the world: This mountain excursion promises rich variety in every respect. At the summit, the glorious panorama of Lake Geneva and the surrounding Alps unfolds.

**Stanserhorn, 1,900 m**  
Marmot corrals, plant protection areas and delicious culinary experiences: The "viewing plateau" of the Lucerne region links history to presence – in the open-air CabriO cableway in combination with a funicular dating back to 1893. All with a view of 100 kilometres of the Alps and 10 lakes. The visit to Stanserhorn is fully included in the Swiss Travel Pass.

Between St.Gallen and Lucerne, guests discover a different kind of Switzerland: They savour the picturesque villages, gently undulating hills and untouched natural beauty of the Voralpen.

**By train and boat straight to the hiking highlights**  
It's not only mountains and eternal ice that infuse Switzerland with their scenic magic but also numerous rivers and lakes. Taken all together, there's the promise of a unique experience of natural splendour: by train, by boat, and on foot.

The excursion starts with a delightful train ride to Flüelen. There, an imposing steamer or a modern motor vessel awaits. In style, one glides across Lake Lucerne and reaches the stop "Rütli", starting point of the path towards the history-steeped "Rütliwiese" (Rütli Meadow). Now hikers set off on the "Path of Switzerland", which leads through enchanting forests on well-signalised hiking trails. Visitors are rewarded with a magnificent view of the lake and the mountainscape.

Boat cruises on Lake Lucerne can be enjoyed year-round and are also suitable for travelling to winter hiking trails on Mount Rigi.



Swiss mountain lakes – Stars on social media platforms.



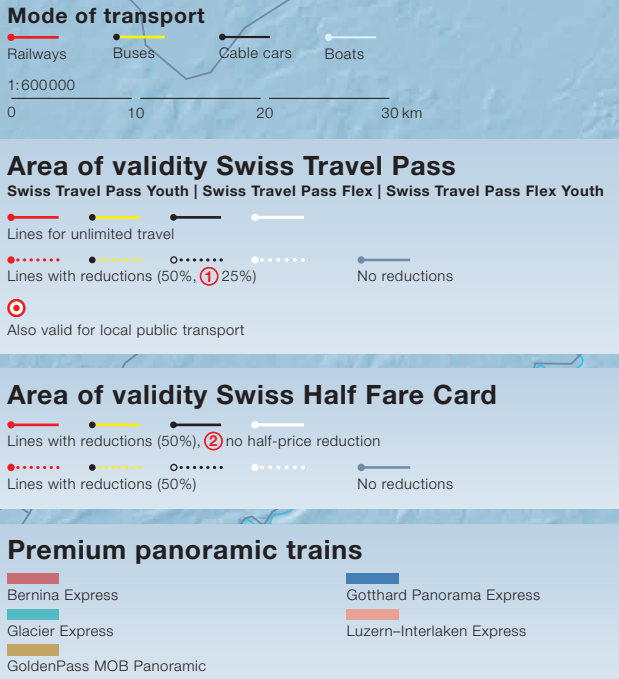
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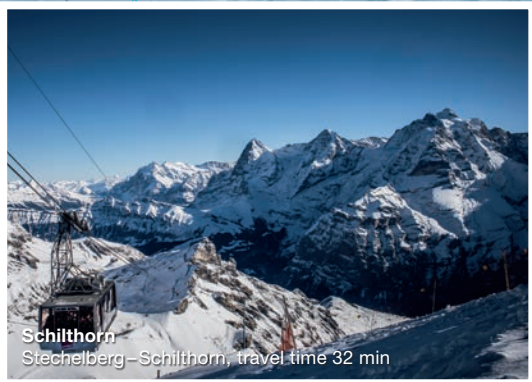

The premium panoramic trains.

Swiss premium panoramic trains enjoy international renown. They delight visitors with modern conveniences and large panoramic windows ensuring unobstructed views of the scenic splendours characterising the Alpine nation.

**Bernina Express:** from Chur to Tirano or Lugano  
From north to south, from glaciers to palm trees – tackling gradients of up to 70 % on the way, the route crosses the

Soils Viaduct and climbs to the Ospizio Bernina at 2,253 metres. In summer, the journey can be extended aboard the Bernina Express Bus from Tirano along Lake Como to Lugano.

**Glacier Express:** from Zermatt to St. Moritz  
Glacier Express takes passengers on a journey for the senses: from the Matterhorn to the Engadin. With its ceiling-high panoramic windows, the adventure train offers an unobstructed view of unique landscapes along the way.

**GoldenPass MOB Panoramic:** from Zweisimmen to Montreux  
During the journey on the GoldenPass MOB Panoramic, the tradition-rich Bernese Oberland merges with the Mediterranean flair of French-speaking Switzerland. The ride in the VIP seats right at the front of the train is a particularly impressive experience.

**Gotthard Panorama Express:** from Lugano to Luzern  
Tracing Switzerland's history – by land and by water: The journey combines the panoramic train with a stately steamboat passage and is accompanied by interesting staged presentations about history and myths around Gotthard. From Ticino via the historic Gotthard route and Lake Lucerne, the journey eventually takes visitors to lovely Lucerne.

**Luzern-Interlaken Express:** from Luzern to Interlaken  
Step on the train in Central Switzerland, lean back, and arrive in the Jungfrau region just under two hours later. The enjoyable train ride on the Luzern-Interlaken Express leads past turquoise lakes and numerous waterfalls.

Scenic mountain adventures.

A quintet of highlights – in every way. Authentic. Sustainable. Impressive. And experienced at a discount by Swiss Travel Pass holders.

**Gornergrat, 3,089 m**  
Amid no fewer than 29 4,000-metre peaks, the Gornergrat offers a spectacular 360° panoramic view from the Matterhorn to the Dufourspitze. From Zermatt station, Europe's highest-altitude open-air cog railway takes passengers towards this stunning summit – 365 days a year.

**Jungfrau, 3,454 m**  
Top of Europe – high Alpine fascination of eternal ice and snow. It's a destination of unending magical power. Clear days allow the eye to rove almost endlessly from the Vosges to the Black Forest. The train arrives via tunnels through the glaciers of Eiger and Mönch.

**Rigi, 1,797 m**  
The "Queen of the Swiss Mountains" – easily accessible by train, bus and boat: A total of nine mountain railways lead up the enormous rock massive, and 120 kilometres of hiking trails open up a wealth of possibilities. Majestic sunrises and sunsets included. The visit to Rigi is fully included in the Swiss Travel Pass.

**Schilthorn, 2,970 m**  
Piz Gloria – panoramic view in all its glory and the world's first revolving mountain restaurant: The Schilthorn summit highlights the beauty of high Alpine scenery to perfection. It also presents the UNESCO World Heritage Site with Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau in the most spectacular light. The visit to Schilthorn is fully included in the Swiss Travel Pass.

**Titlis, 3,020 m**  
It's the only accessible glacier in Central Switzerland and sports the highest rope bridge in Europe – not to mention an impressive glacier relief. Even the ride up to the summit in the Titlis Rotair, the world's first revolving cableway gondola, is an adventure.
